WELCOME, FRIEND!

Imagine yourself tucked away on 110 acres of fir and pine forest; feeling the air gently blowing through the branches high above you, enjoying the scent of the fresh air as you walk through the Manastash Canyon, and listening to the flow of the creek in front of your cabin.

Let our clean, functional, and comfortable facilities be the place for your next retreat or conference. We are open to the *non-profit* community on a year-round basis, providing Christian hospitality and programming for persons of all ages, abilities, and cultural backgrounds.

In addition to enjoying our homemade meals, guests may simply relish the solitude of our peaceful surroundings or participate in many recreational opportunities such as hiking on our seven miles of trails, creating in our Craft Cabin, bonding on our Challenge Course, ice skating and inner tubing in the winter, and year-round license-free trout fishing.

At Lazy F Camp and Retreat Center we acknowledge that each group is unique and customize our service and programs to give groups the quality service they desire. Come and let us share our hospitality with you!



ACCOMMODATIONS

Lazy F provides a variety of accommodations to meet the needs of your group. All of our buildings are heated and available all year. Group members provide their own bedding to use on the bunk beds. In Skyline linen is provided for most groups.

LAZY F LODGE: A 2-story building, hosting both the Dining Hall, with a capacity of 96 at one meal, and Lower Lodge, a meeting room with 2 large restrooms complete with showers. For gatherings, 100 folding chairs are available. *Accessible.*

SKYLINE: Our newest facility constructed with predominantly volunteer support is specifically designed for adult and family groups. Skyline features 8 bedrooms (each with a private bathroom), linen service, a comfortable meeting space (with a gas fireplace and kitchenette), and an inspiring view of the ridgeline and cross. Capacity is 31 people. *Accessible.*

RIDGEVIEW: Houses 40 guests in 10 rooms of 4 beds each. A restroom with 2 showers, sinks and commodes is located in each wing. Fully equipped kitchen and central meeting area with piano. *Facility accessible, bathrooms are not.*

TRADING POST: From our dude ranch days in the 30's! Houses 30 guests in 3 dorm-style rooms. Restrooms in each wing. Carpeted central area for meetings with piano and fireplace. Fully equipped kitchen. *Accessible.*

WHITE GLEN: A cozy cabin across from Trading Post, sleeps 8 guests. A favorite for leaders of large groups. Single bathroom.

LOG CABINS: Three rustic log cabins on the banks of the creek sleep 12 guests each.

SADDLE POCKETS: Located up on a hill, this building sleeps 18 in 3 bedrooms. Small meeting space and central bathrooms.

Capacity: 163



ADDITIONAL FEATURES

RV HOOKUPS: There are 6 electrical stations located near the main parking lot. No dump station available.

TENT AREAS: A meadow next to the Lodge is available for tenting, with a capacity for 20 family sized tents. Bathrooms and showers are located in the Lower Lodge.

TEPEE VILLAGE: Three large tepees with canvas sides sleep 7 guests each. Outdoor fire circle. One-third of a mile from main camp area. Port-a-toilets are available with advance notice, and for an additional charge.

RECREATION

FISHING: Our pond is stocked annually with rainbow trout, and is the perfect place to enjoy license-free catch-and-release fishing. Children may keep and take home one fish during their stay. Only barbless hooks are allowed. **Swimming is not allowed in the pond.** All water activities require the presence of an adult with current Red Cross Standard First Aid and CPR at the site.



CHALLENGE COURSE: There is no better way to bring a group together than by sharing adventurous experiences. This adventure-based tool utilizes structured activities with elements, ropes, and cables so the group members may learn more about themselves and each other. More information and costs may be obtained by contacting the camp at least two months prior to use. **Groups are not allowed to facilitate their own challenge course programs.**

SNOW TUBING HILL: Usually available December-February, the tubing hill's popularity is renown all over Washington! Only camp inner tubes (available at no additional charge) are allowed to speed down one of our four runs.

CRAFT CABIN: There are two different options available for the use of this building: For a small fee, our staff will provide materials and instruction to create crafts appropriate for your group, or you may provide supplies and leadership and use the craft cabin at no charge.

THE BARN: Upstairs is a wooden floor loft with high ceiling suitable for basketball (one hoop), gym games, and barn dances. Downstairs is a carpeted multi-purpose room for meetings and activities. Ping-pong, billiards, foosball, air hockey, and seating for meetings are available in this room.

DIRECTIONS TO LAZY F

Centrally located for easy access from all over the Pacific Northwest!

FROM SEATTLE (about 2 hours):

I-90 East to Thorp Exit #101

Turn right at stop sign

Proceed 1.9 miles – turn right onto Cove Road

Proceed 4.3 miles to Manastash Road (2nd stop sign) – turn right

Wind up the canyon 6.9 miles

Lazy F is on the left side of the road

FROM YAKIMA (about 1 hour):

I-82 North to I-90 West

Take Exit #109 (Ellensburg/ Canyon Road) - Turn **right**

Turn **left** at Umptanum Road (at Subway, across from McDonald's)

Go 1.6 miles and turn **right** at Manastash Road (Schoolhouse #7 on right)

Go 10 miles past the hay fields and up the canyon to Camp

FROM SPOKANE (about 3 hours):

I-90 West to exit #109 (Ellensburg/Canyon Road)

Turn **right**

Turn **left** at Umptanum Road (at Subway, across from McDonald's)

Go 1.6 miles and turn **right** at Manastash Road (Schoolhouse #7 on right)

Go 10 miles past the hay fields and up the canyon to Camp

FROM WENATCHEE (about 90 minutes):

Highway 97 South to Perkins Restaurant

Turn **right**

Go 0.4 miles and turn **left** at KOA onto Thorp Hwy.

Go 0.3 miles and turn **left** at Hanson Road

Go 2.8 miles and turn **left** at Cove Road

Go 1.0 miles and turn **right** at Manastash Road

Go 6.9 miles up the canyon to Camp

Lazy F is located on the left side of the road. Go past the barn with "Lazy F" on the side, the main entrance is beyond this barn and the big field. There is a sign at the entrance and the office is the first building on the left.

SITE USE GUIDLINES

SAFETY:

1. Guest groups may not bring gas or flammable materials, explosives, poisonous substances (cleaning agents), or power tools onto camp property.
2. Please be careful with fire. No fireworks allowed. Open fires allowed only in designated campfire areas.
3. Do not drink irrigation water from hoses, the creek, or pond.
4. Animals and pets should not be brought to camp. No animals or pets allowed in buildings, except service dogs.
5. **ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES, ILLEGAL DRUGS, AND FIREARMS ARE STRICTLY PROHIBITED ON CAMP PROPERTY!**
6. Smoking is discouraged for reasons of health, safety, and fire hazard. Smoking is limited to the large fire circle north of the lodge. Other areas may be designated by the Camp Director.
7. All water activities require the presence of an adult with current Red Cross Standard First Aid and CPR at the water site.

HEALTH SERVICES:

All groups are responsible for their own health services and supplies and must provide a person currently certified in at least Red Cross Standard First Aid and CPR to be present at all times when participants are on camp grounds. The nearest hospital is Kittitas Valley Community Hospital in Ellensburg (15-20 minutes). Groups are to provide their own emergency transportation or call an ambulance (911) if necessary.

MEAL SERVICES:

Guests consistently comment on the quality of our meal service. We take great pride in the variety of options available during our all-you-can-eat buffet. Meals are homemade with fresh baked breads and desserts. The minimum number of guests Lazy F will serve is twenty, but many weekends several groups combine together to meet this minimum. Groups under 40 people have an option of cooking their own meals in one of two facilities equipped for that purpose.

PHONE SERVICE:

At Lazy F, we cherish our sheltered location deep in the Manastash Canyon. This provides a sense of being secluded from the events of everyday life. The fact that we do not receive cell phone service allows our guests to focus on the events and people of the retreat. The nearest location for cell service is about 10 minutes down the canyon in a vehicle. There is a phone available outside the office for local, calling card, and collect calls.

RESERVATIONS

Lazy F Camp and Retreat Center is a ministry of the United Methodist Church. Our mission is to be a sanctuary of hospitality, renewal, and learning within God's natural world that celebrates diversity, inspires love and service, and fulfills our special partnership with local churches in the development of Christian disciples and spiritual leaders.



Reservations for Lazy F Camp and Retreat Center are available to nonprofit organizations without regard to race, color, creed, sex, sexual orientation, age, or national origin, disability, or veteran status.

RESERVATIONS ARE REQUIRED: Reservations may be made by phone (509 962-2780), email (office@lazyfcamp.org), or in person at the Lazy F Camp office. A reservation date will be held temporarily by verbal agreement for fourteen days. A Reservation Agreement will be provided to outline the specifics of your event. Your reservation will be confirmed upon receipt of the signed Reservation Agreement and a reservation deposit. This deposit will be credited to your final billing, and is due one month after you receive the agreement. The *non-refundable and non-transferable* deposit is determined by the estimated size of your group:

25 or less persons: \$50.00	76-100 persons: \$200.00
26-50 persons: \$100.00	4 or more nights, any size \$300.00
51-75 persons: \$150.00	

ADVANCE PAYMENT: Twenty-five percent (25%) of the total estimated fees is due six weeks prior to your scheduled event as an advance payment. The advance payment is non-refundable and non-transferrable should your group cancel less than six weeks prior to your event. When hazardous road/weather conditions cause a road closure upon which group members will be driving, which is neither the fault of the camp nor the group, fifty percent (50%) of the advance payment will be refunded. The advance payment will be credited to your final bill. The balance of your bill is due within one month of departure from Lazy F Camp.

EXCLUSIVE USE: We typically have more than one group on site at a time. Groups wishing guaranteed exclusive use of the camp are required to pay a minimum of seventy-five percent (75%) of camp capacity (122 people) for lodging costs at regular rates.
